



ELIGIBILITY:

Full- or part-time students who have paid health fees and are currently enrolled in classes are eligible for health services.

Services Offered

All services are completely confidential (with special legal exceptions).

The Mission of the Student Health & Wellness Center is:

- To provide accessible, affordable ambulatory care for family planning and treatment of minor acute illnesses and injuries.
- To prepare students to be better informed health-care consumers and active participants in their own health-care.
- To encourage and educate students to avoid unnecessary illness and injury in achieving levels of wellness.
- To provide emotional support through periods of stress.

Special Summer and Winter session hours will be posted.

Closed weekends, holidays, and when classes are not in session.

- First aid
- Blood pressure checks
- HIV testing
- Mental health counseling
- Nutritional counseling
- Men's & Women's Clinic
 - Family planning information,
 - Pap test, birth control pills, Plan B,
 - Depo-Provera, STD Exams, etc.
- TB skin tests and immunizations
- Tobacco cessation counseling
- Treatment of short-term illnesses (*bladder infection, sore throat, etc.*)
- Referrals to specialists
- Self-Help Center (over-the-counter medications)
- Educational pamphlets
- Nominal charge for some items: (*pregnancy tests, lab charges, condoms, prescription meds, etc.*)



TREATMENT OF MINORS

Students under the age of 18 are required at admission to have parental consent signed that allows treatment at the health center. Parental consent is not required for emergencies or cases exempted by law, such as reproductive health care.

INSURANCE INFORMATION

A voluntary group medical-surgical hospital insurance plan is available to students and their dependents at low cost. Applications are available at the Student Health & Wellness Center or online at www.canyons.edu/offices/HHealth.

No insurance is required to visit the Student Health & Wellness Center, where office visits are free.
